
Salvation Army Christmas Toy Appeal

<u>Welcome and Opening Prayer</u> <u>Confession</u> Jesus says, 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand.' So let us turn away from sin and turn to the Lord, confessing our sins in penitence and faith:

Please join in with the response to 'Father God' – 'We ask for your forgiveness.'

Father God, We ask for your forgiveness...

Jesus Christ, risen Master and triumphant Lord, we come to you in sorrow for our sins, and confess to you our weakness and unbelief:
