

Master, we hear Your call:
help us to follow.

Jesus said: 'Go to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples, and I will be with you always, to the end of the age –'
Master, we hear Your call:
help us to follow.

Lord, You have redeemed us and called us into Your service: give us grace to hear Your word and to obey Your commandments; for Your mercy's sake. *Amen.*

day by day. Amen.


Keep us, Father, in this community of faith, the Church of Your Son Jesus Christ, and help us to confess Him as Messiah and Lord in all we say and do.
