

<u>Confession</u>

Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. Let us confess our sins remembering before God the times when we have fallen from temptation into sin...

We are truly sorry and repent of all our sins. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, who died for us, forgive us all that is past and grant that we may serve you in newness of life to the glory of your name. Amen.

Almighty God, who forgives all who truly repent, have mercy on you, pardon and deliver you from all your sins, confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, and keep you in eternal life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

<u>Collect of the Day</u>

Almighty God, you show to those who are in error the light of your truth that they may return to the way of righteousness: Grant to all those who are admitted into the fellowship of Christ's religion, that they may reject those things that are contrary to their profession, and follow all such things as are agreeable to the same; through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Almighty and everlasting God, you hate nothing that you have made and forgive the sins of all those who are penitent: Create and make in us new and contrite hearts that we, worthily lamenting our sins and acknowledging our wretchedness, may receive from you, the God of all mercy, perfect remission and forgiveness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

Prayers and Intercessions

In our prayers and intercessions this morning, the response to 'In all things, Lord' will be 'teach us to follow.'

In all things, Lord, **teach us to follow.**

Loving God, we thank You for the example of Christ: the faith that gave Him strength to resist temptation and accept Your will; the courage to take the path of suffering and death; and the love that guides us still . . . In all things, Lord, **teach us to follow.**

Forgive us those times when we give so little, even when we know we have received so much from Him. Forgive us those times when we are self-seeking, putting ourselves before others and before You, shying away from sacrifice and self-denial . . . In all things, Lord, teach us to follow.

Loving God, assure us again of Your constant mercy, cleanse and renew our hearts, give us strength, faith and courage to follow where You would lead us . . . In all things, Lord, **teach us to follow.**

Teach us to hunger and thirst for righteousness, knowing that You are able to fill us. Teach us to trust in You always, come what may, knowing that Your love will never fail us. Teach us to offer You our worship through all we are and all we do, knowing that You alone are God. In all things, Lord, **teach us to follow.**

We take a moment now to remember before God all those known to us who are ill, bereaved and in distress . . .

And we offer to God the prayers of our own hearts . . .

Loving God, lead us in the days to come, so that, in trusting and loving You, we would know Your presence with us always. In all things, Lord, **teach us to follow.** *Amen.*

The Lord's Prayer

Let's say together: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.
